


1 Download & install



Plug OBD connector (DLC)

The DLC is usually found on the driver's side, under the dash.



—Can't find your DLC? Visit dlc-locator.com


3 Turn ignition on

'Power' LED will turn ON, and the **'BT'** LED will start flashing *slowly*.

—LEDs are off? Check vehicle for blown fuses.



Make sure 'Bluetooth' is enabled, then tap 'Bluetooth settings'.

LED will switch to a fast blink.



Attention!

You must complete steps 7, 8, and 9 within **2 minutes.** If you need more time, press the button again.

7 Tap 'Scan for devices',



[instructions continue on reverse]

You **do not** need to confirm the passkey.

Once successfully paired, OBD will appear as 'Paired but not connected':

10 Launch the OBD app, and tap 'Connect'

Once the connection is established, the 'BT' LED will turn on solid. Tap 'Diagnostics' to start a scan.
